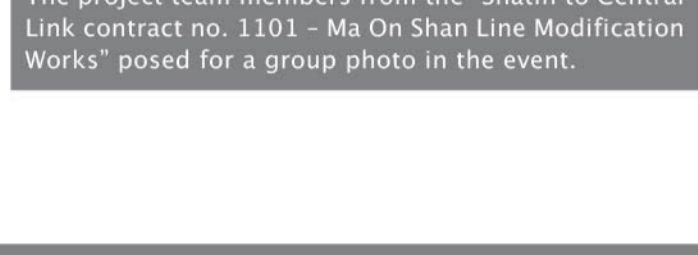

The ceremony was organized by the MTR Corporation to present the first bi-annual awards in 2015 for its contractors that had achieved high standard of quality management performance. The bi-annual competition aims at encouraging its contractors to implement effective quality management systems, to provide quality works and service and to develop strong safety culture.

Sun Fook Kong started the construction work since July, 2012 with its scope of works that include the extension of station platforms and roof, the enhancement of electrical and mechanical facilities, the Automatic Platform Gates enabling works, the extension of overrun viaduct at Wu Kai Sha Station, the retrofitting of noise enclosure at Tai Wai Station and viaduct near Fok On Garden and the re-provisioning of Shek Mun Playground.

Sun Fook Kong always emphasizes on quality, safety and environmental protection. The Group also strives to care for the community including the neighborhoods and pedestrians, as well as to execute the project in an efficient manner.

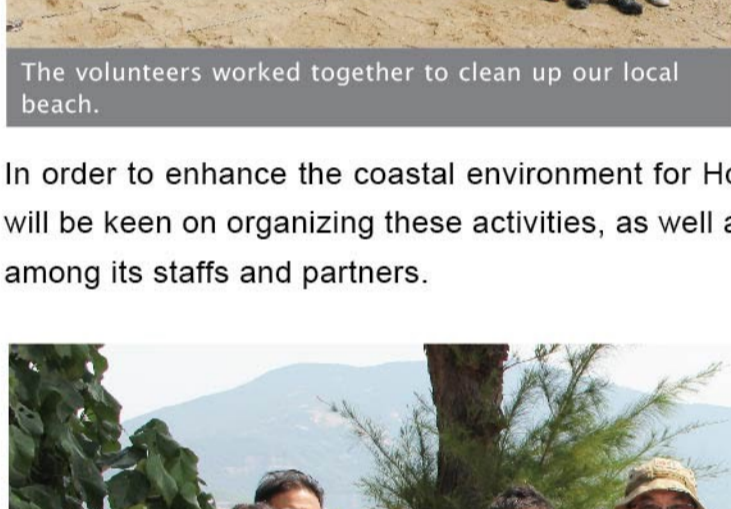

During the three hours, the volunteers had successfully collected, classified and handled over 83.4 kilogram marine debris on the Stanley Main Beach. Mr. Eric Chau, Chairman of the Sun Fook Kong Volunteer Team said, "This is a very meaningful event which can make the Stanley Main Beach cleaner and tidier. It can also build up team spirit among our volunteers." To encourage our volunteers to work with more vitality, the Group had established several awards, including "Heaviest Piece of Rubbish Award" and "Most Unique Trash Award".

## Sun Fook Kong Joins Hands with the Construction Industry to Organize a Heart Health Seminar

To raise the workers' awareness towards heart diseases, Sun Fook Kong in collaboration with The Hong Kong Registered Contractors Association and Care For Your Heart to organize a heart health seminar on 10 August 2015. The event had successfully gained the support from over 30 government departments and associations, including the Development Bureau, the Labour Department and the Occupational Safety and Health Council. Ms. Lau Suet Ting, Consultant Doctor in Cardiology of the Princess Margaret Hospital was invited to be the guest speaker. Over 150 management staffs and workers from different construction companies attended the event.

Nowadays, heart disease has become the second biggest killer of both men and women in Hong Kong, killing nearly five thousand people annually. Coronary heart disease is the most common type of heart disease. In the past, some workers who died suddenly as a result of coronary heart disease had shown no previous symptoms. Mr. Andrew Kwok, Chairman of the event and Project Director of Sun Fook Kong said during his speech, "Bringing better health to the workers means lowering the chance of having construction accidents. The management staffs should care for the health condition of their workers, to provide sufficient rest time to them and to reduce their work pressure. We also encourage companies to organize more health talks and meaningful activities, so as to enhance the health awareness on their workers."

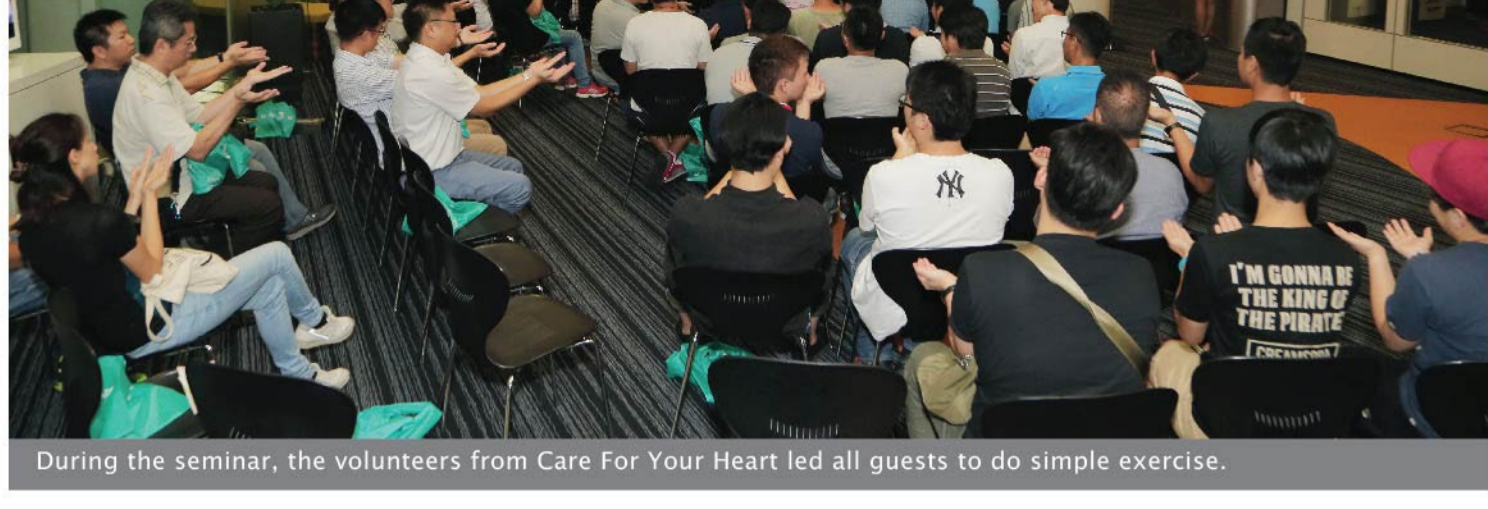
Mr. Szeto Chi Wing, Director of Sun Fook Kong was invited to share his heart disease experience at the seminar.
