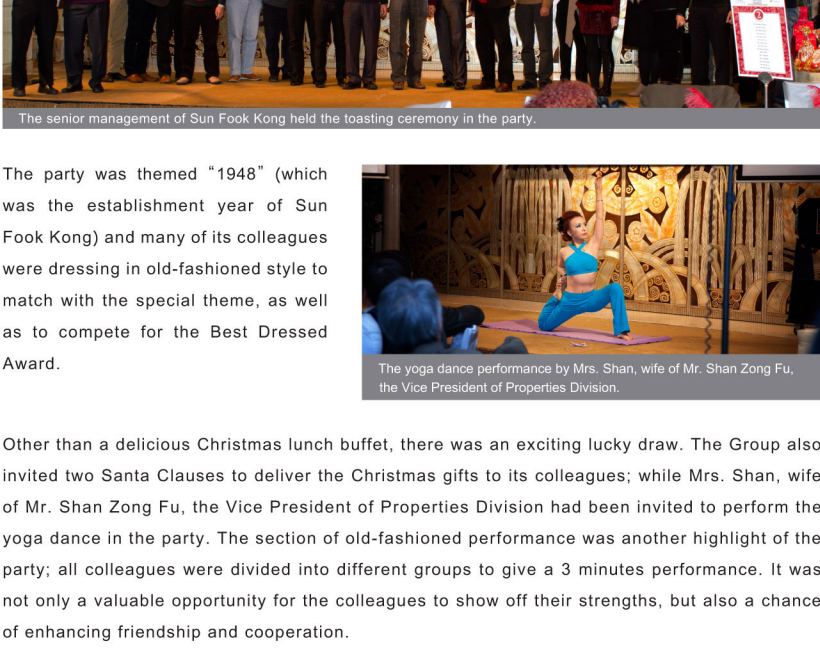


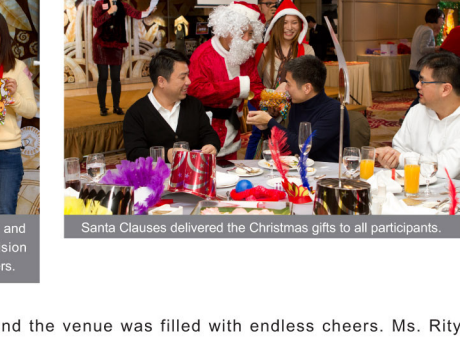
Sun Fook Kong Organized the "1948 Old-Fashioned Christmas Party"

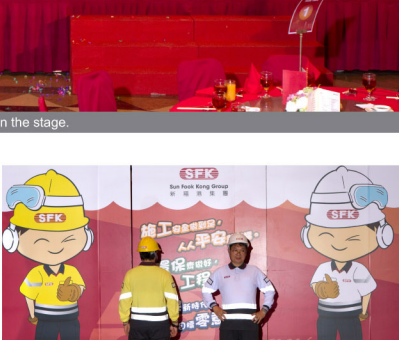


Santa Clauses delivered the Christmas gifts to all participants.

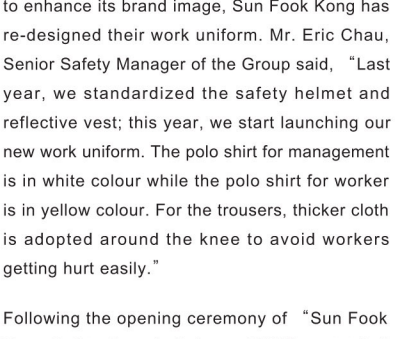


"Sun Fook Kong Safety Awards Scheme 2013" Officially Launched

Sun Fook Kong held the opening ceremony of "Sun Fook Kong Safety Awards Scheme 2013" at the Kowloonbay International Trade & Exhibition Centre on 11 January. Over 380 staffs from Sun Fook Kong Project Management and Safety Department and contractors attended the event.

Mr. Patrick Lee, Managing Director of Construction and Safety Director of the Group said during his opening speech, "Sun Fook Kong strives to achieve "Zero Accident". We will keep pursuing a safety culture and strengthen our safety monitoring system, to ensure all our workers are working safely."

To bring greater convenience to the workers and to enhance its brand image, Sun Fook Kong has re-designed their work uniform. Mr. Eric Chau, Senior Safety Manager of the Group, said, "Last year, we standardized the safety helmet and reflective vest; this year, we start launching our new work uniform. The polo shirt for management is in white colour while the polo shirt for worker is in yellow colour. For the trousers, thicker cloth is adopted around the knee to avoid workers getting hurt easily."



Two emcees wore the new work uniform on the stage to demonstrate its new design to the audience.

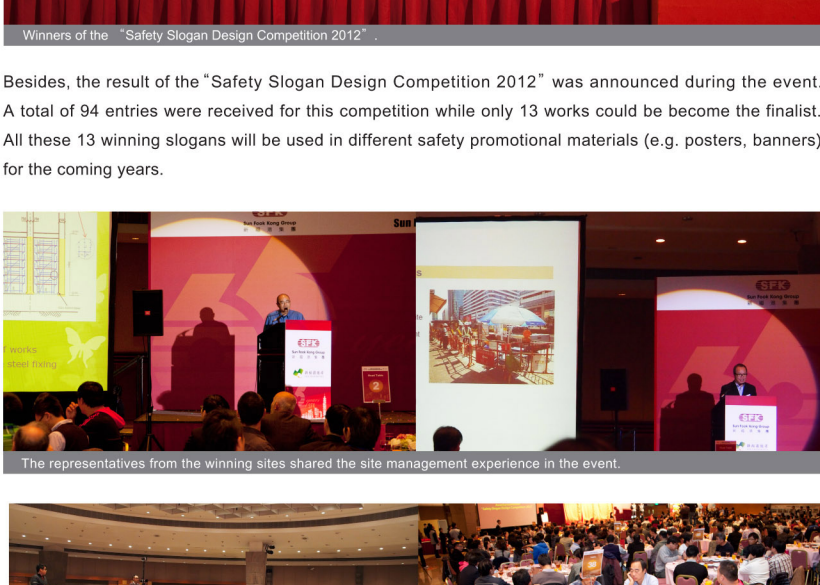

The big winners of the night were the project of "SFK-Biwater Joint Venture: Harbour Area Treatment Scheme 2A - Upgrading at Stonecutters Island Sewage Treatment Works - Main Pumping Station, Sedimentation Tanks and Ancillary Facilities winning the championship of "The Best Performance Project Safety Award" and the first runner-up of "Good Housekeeping Award"; and the project of "Provision of Lift Shafts at LCK, SWH & PRE" receiving the first runner-up of "The Best Performance Project Safety Award" together with the championship of "Good Housekeeping Award".

The project of "Provision of Lift Shafts at LCK, SWH & PRE" also won two awards.

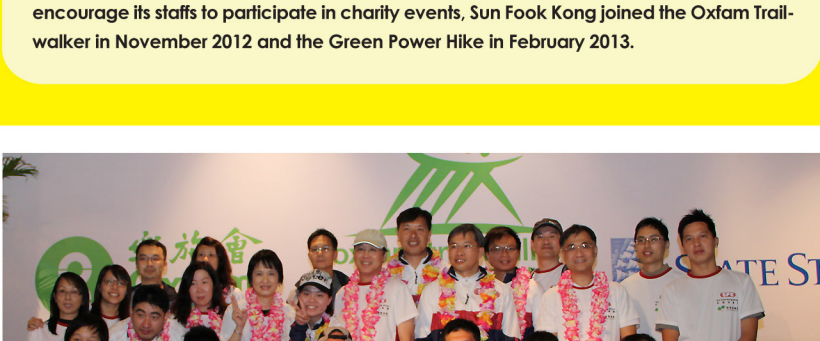


Winners of the "Safety Slogan Design Competition 2012".

In order to raise funds for various poverty alleviation and emergency relief projects and to encourage its staffs to participate in charity events, Sun Fook Kong joined the Oxfam Trailwalker in November 2012 and the Green Power Hike in February 2013.

Oxfam Trailwalker is a 100-kilometre long event organized by Oxfam Hong Kong. The participants are required to take the 100km challenge along the MacLehose Trail and other Trails (including Tai Mo Shan, which is the highest peak in Hong Kong) in teams of four, aiming to finish within 48 hours. The Start Point of the event is at Pak Tam Chung in Sai Kung and the Finish Point is at Po Leung Kuk Jockey Club, Tai Hong Holiday Camp in Yuen Long. Finally, Sun Fook Kong Team successfully completed the trail in 30 hours and 36 minutes.
