

Sun Fook Kong Summer Internship Programme 2013

In order to bring up the outstanding talents in the construction industry, Sun Fook Kong organizes the internship programme every summer. This year, the project team of "Shatin to Central Link Contract no. 1101 – Ma On Shan Line Modification Works" recruited 4 interns with different backgrounds. The interns would receive on-site trainings and gain experience to work in a construction site.



Sun Fook Kong strives to serve the community and emphasizes on the future development of our society. The internship programme aims to enhance the young people's understanding on construction industry so as to attract them to join the industry; and in the meantime train up more talents for the community.

The internship programme allows the senior management to instill messages to the trainees. Mr. Jimmy Shing, the Senior Project Manager of Sun Fook Kong often reminds the interns, "Safety is the most important element in construction sector. Our responsibility is to plan an effective and safe schedule of work and to work it out in practice. All of us are required to address safety seriously regardless which position we are, as keeping our labors safe is always ranked above site progress or monetary gain."





Sun Fook Kong has arranged different trainings for the four individuals according to their wills and their abilities, giving them a chance to apply the knowledge they acquired and to assist them going towards their goals. Huang Mian, Fung Kai Hang, Tung Chi Hoi and Wong Chark Yu are students taking Civil Engineering in the University of Hong Kong, Architecture in Chu Hai College of Higher Education, Engineering in City University of Hong Kong and Civil Engineering and Environmental Engineering in the University of Hawaii at Manoa respectively. During the training period, the interns learnt about site management, construction drawings, safety planning, contract formulation and other related aspects.

The interns left the programme with some special moments. One of the interns, Fung Kai Hang expressed, "It is unforgettable to host morning briefing section for the workers. The workers' working attitudes are passionate and they will never hesitate to voice their opinions. I discover that two-way communication is the key in speeding up the working process as it allows us to learn more about the physical condition of the sites." Other than good communication with the labours, it is crucial to keep contact with the client, Wong Chark Yu expressed, "We always have to maintain close liaison with our client and various stakeholders to ensure our work will not affect the daily operation of MTR, as well as to minimize the negative impact to the public that caused by construction activities."



Besides, the 4 Interns gained a lot after participating in the programme. Huang Mian said, "Among the 9 stations and Shek Mun Playground under the contract, some of them have just started while some of them are close to completion, which allows us to observe the early, middle and the late stages of the construction process. I am content with this allrounded learning and experiencing opportunity." Moreover, the interns have established genuine friendship, Tung Chi Hoi said, "Not only the managers and the colleagues, the other interns had also taught me a lot. Team spirit is vital in all projects; different parties have to get hand in hand in order to complete the goals."

Sun Fook Kong started undertaking the "Shatin to Central Link contract no. 1101 - Ma On Shan Line Modification Works" since July, 2012, its scope of works include the extension of station platforms and roof, the enhancement of electrical and mechanical facilities, the Automatic Platform Gates enabling works, the extension of overrun viaduct at Wu Kai Sha Station, the retrofitting of noise enclosure at Tai Wai Station and viaduct near Fok On Garden and the reprovisioning of Shek Mun Playground. The internship programme has widened the interns' horizon; they have also revealed that the fame in construction sector is no longer

built up by the knowledge and the monetary gain, but by safety, humanity, collaboration and communication instead.

In the near future, Sun Fook Kong will grasp more chances for training the talents and work hard for a better future for the community.

Sun Fook Kong Actively Participated in the "Construction Safety Week 2013"

Sun Fook Kong actively joint the "Construction Safety Week 2013" which was jointly organized by the Development Bureau and Construction Industry Council. The 5 days event started on the 27 May, 2013 with the theme of this year, "Zero accident. Zero harm".

"Construction Safety Week-Zero Accidents Ambassadors Commendation Ceremony" was the kickoff of the series of events. It took place at the Kai Tak Development Area. The Chief Executive led the pledge, "One-minded, united, for ourselves, for our families, having zero accident, enjoy life with our family". It was also the first large-scale morning assembly organized in Hong Kong. The morning assembly was broadcasted to more than 800 sites. A number of Sun Fook Kong sites participated in the event which the workers have made a commitment concerning to make their working environment having zero accident.

"Zero Accident Ambassador Award" was established to show the appreciation towards the foremen and the workers for their contributions in keeping the working environment safe. Recently, Mr. Michael Fong, Chief Assistant Secretary of Development Bureau visited the site of "Kai Tak Development - Reconstruction and Upgrading of Kai Tak Nullah Project' and presented the awards to two winners including Mr. Tai Pui Kin and Mr. Law Chung. Mr. Tai Pui Kin, foreman of the Group shared his winning tips, "I always stick to my post, follow the protective measures and wish to be a role model of the workers. Also, taking care of our colleagues and giving them reminders can reduce the chances of accidents happening, these are pivotal in building a harmless working environment.

The Considerate Contractors Site Award Scheme is co-organized by the Development Bureau and the Construction industry Council which aims to boost the building of a responsible and considerate attitude and to promote good site safety, health and environmental practices in the construction industry. The scheme has set several awards and the assessment was based on one's site safety, law abiding, site management, environmental consciousness, being considerate to neighborhood and passers - by, care of workers and others.


