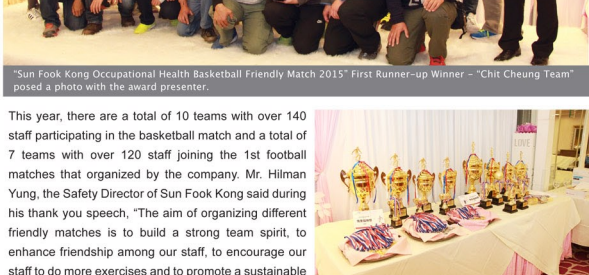

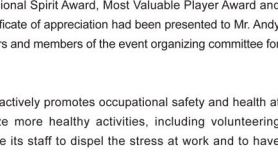


"Sun Fook Kong Occupational Health Basketball Friendly Match 2015" Champion Winner - "Disney team" posed a photo with the award presenter.

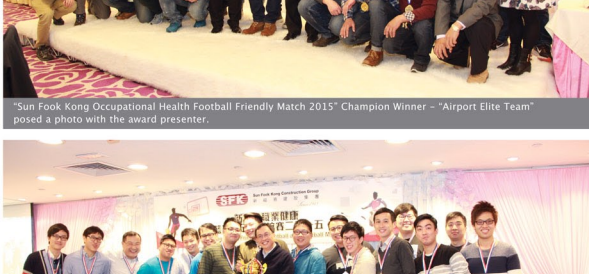

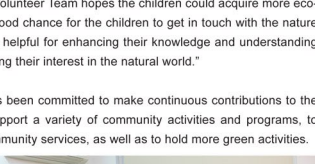
Sun Fook Kong Nature Tour 2016
